

Guide to using Bloomberg printout

If you have access to a Bloomberg terminal, you can print off data and information on your company in a standardized format. I use six printouts from Bloomberg, amounting to 10 pages, to get all the information I need for any company:

If you are interested in the customized FA page, it is simple to create within Bloomberg's conventional FA page. Just click on custom and create the display items that you want.

This is the first page you will get when you type in HDS on a Bloomberg. It lists the top shareholders in your company, listing the number of shares owned and the percent of all outstanding shares.

Check the stock symbol. If there is an alphabet after the symbol, say GOOG A, that suggests that there are multiple classes of shares, usually with different voting rights.

Public Filing from which the information is obtained

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Raw Beta: Regression beta, from regression of returns on stock against specified market index

Adjusted Beta: Regression beta (1-.33) + .33 (Moves beta towards one)

Alpha (Intercept): Regression intercept already in percent (0.202 is 0.202%, not 20.2%). To convert this to a Jensen's alpha = Intercept - Average Riskfree Rate (1- Raw Beta)

R^2: R-squared of regression (a number between 0 and 1), in decimals (0.275 is 27.5%)

R: Correlation between the stock and the market (a number between -1 to +1)

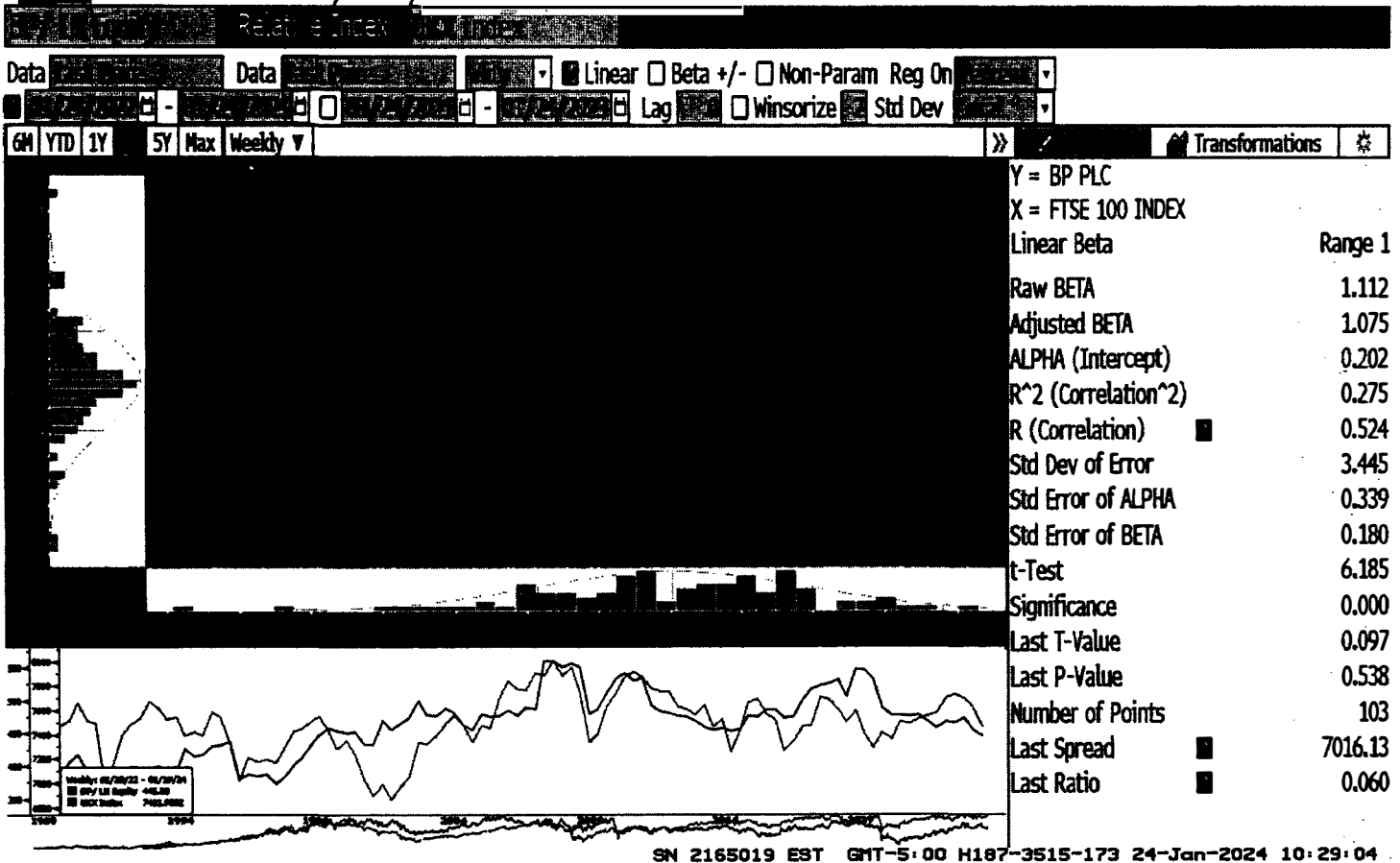
Std Dev of Error: Standard Deviation in difference between actual returns and expected returns, from the regression, during the period

Std Error of ALPHA: Standard error in intercept. To get a range, add or subtract one or two standard errors to or from alpha estimate

Std Error of BETA: Standard error in slope (beta) estimate. To get a range, add or subtract one or two standard errors to or from beta estimate

Ignore the rest. It is statistical debris.

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You can change the index, the starting and ending points for the regression and the intervals (from daily to weekly to monthly...) and whether you use trade prices, bid prices or ask prices.

This is the first of the five pages that should pull up, when you type in DES for your company. Much of the information in these pages is not useful, but it is a good place to get acquainted with your company. This is page 1.

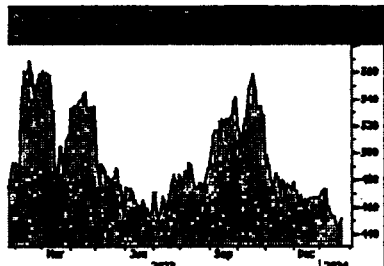

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Page 2 of Five-page DES on your company: This page lists out information about historical stock issuances to the market and general breakdown of shareholders into institutional and insider holdings. Take with a grain of salt, since it is based upon public filings and can reflect subjective decisions on who to include in each group, and can be misleading when you have multiple classes of shares.

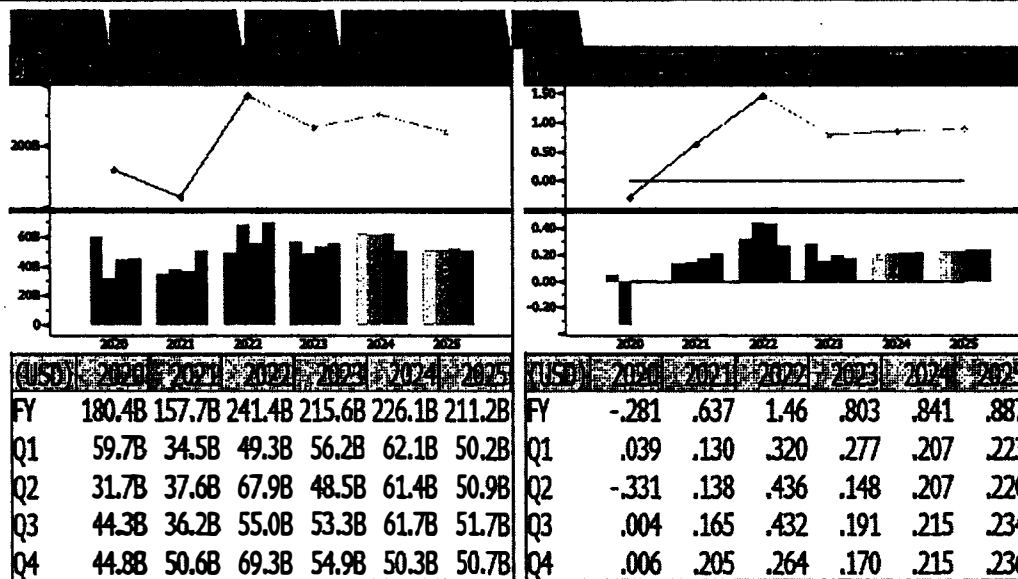

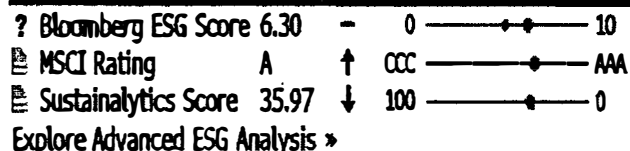

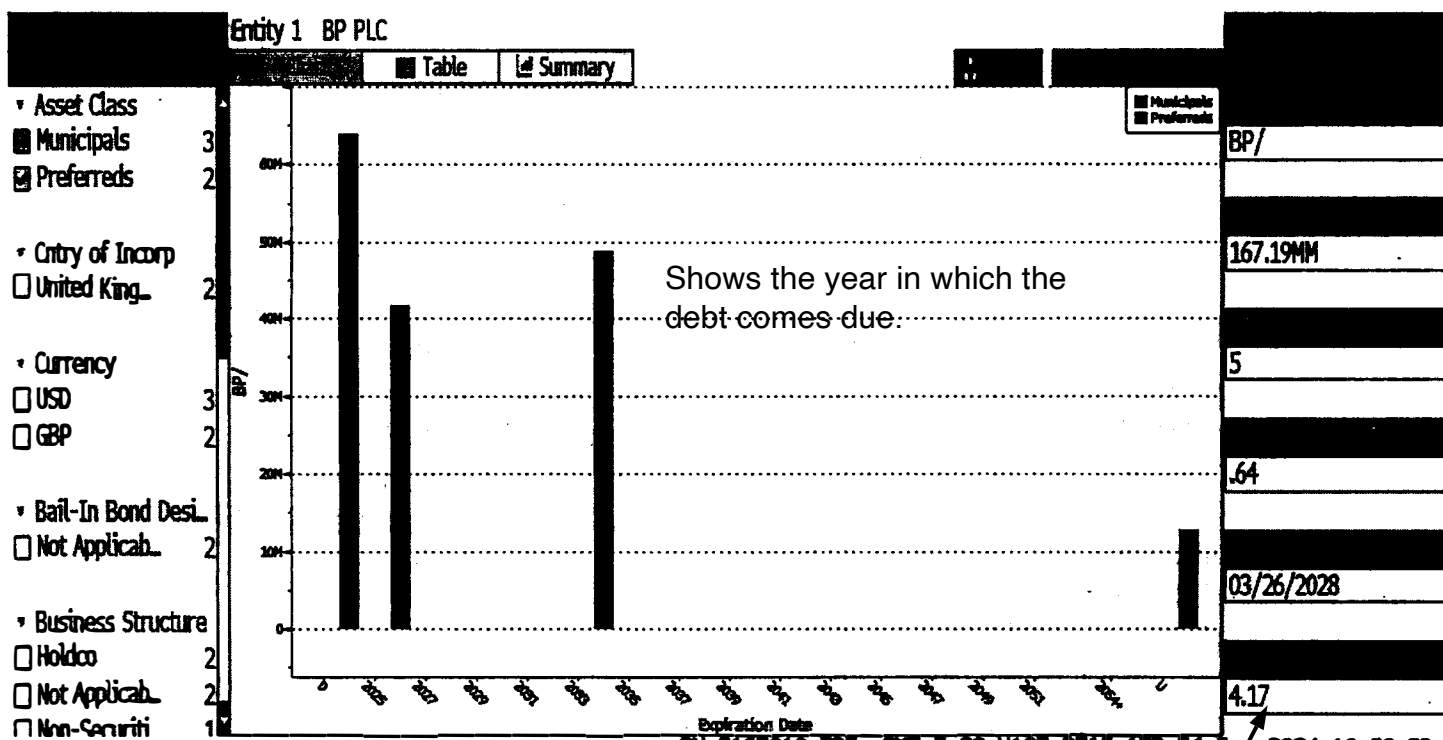

It lists when the debt that the company has outstanding comes due (if you use the options on the left side, you can find the debt broken down by currency). Since Bloomberg is dependent on companies disclosing debt maturity information, and companies are either not forthcoming or opaque, this data might not match up to the debt in the balance sheet or even be close to the truth.

CRPR provides measures of default risk. If the company has a bond rating, this page will list out the ratings from different services, and for local and foreign currency, if it is an emerging market company. If the company does not have a bond rating, Bloomberg offer its own rating measure, which while difficult to translate into a default spread, may still be useful.

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This is the FA page for your company, but when you do open the page in Bloomberg for your company, it will not look like this. However, Bloomberg allows you to modify this page to include any items you want (this is my FA page, reflecting the items I find useful in corporate finance). You can then specify the time period that you want the information for, and voila, you will get a summary of the numbers you need in one page, for your historical time period. Also, Bloomberg allows you to switch currencies and report the numbers in a different currency; the default is the currency in which the company reports its numbers.
