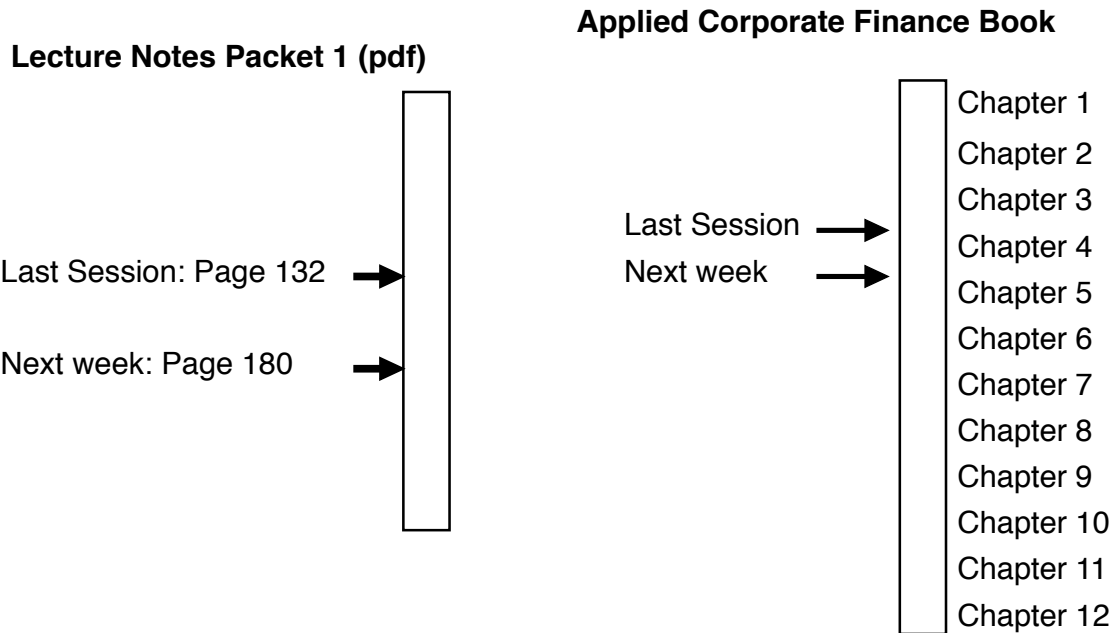
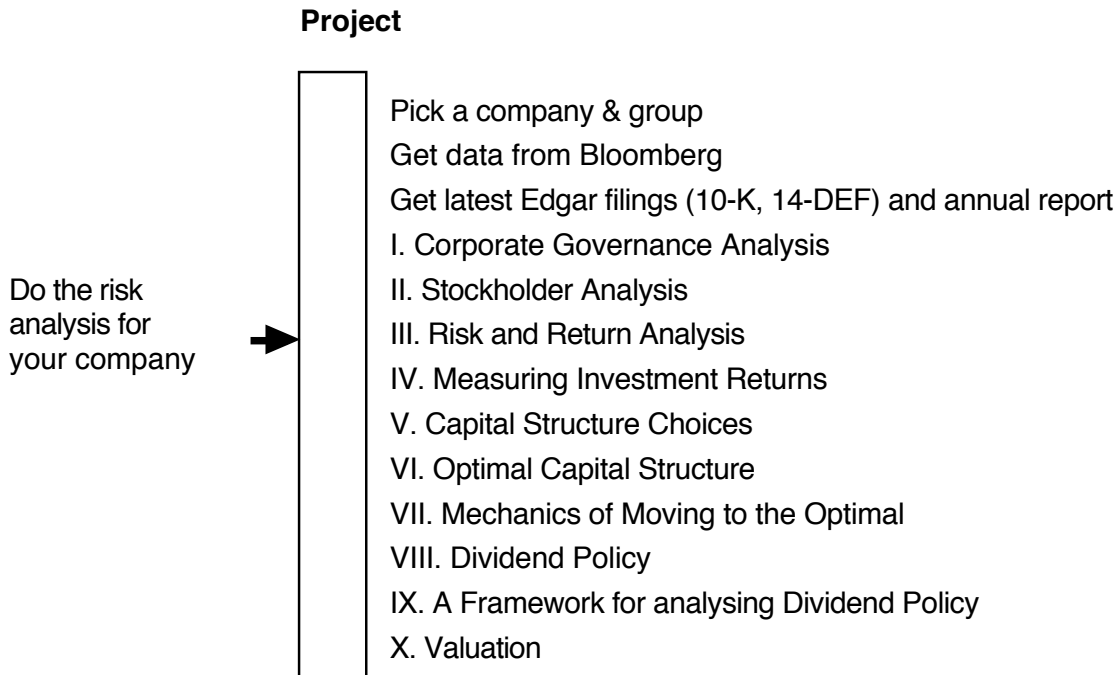

To get a rough measure of the performance of your stock relative to its sector and the market, visit the Morningstar site (enter the index in the interactive graph to the right)
